What is AP Automation?

AP (accounts payable) automation is an expedited system that digitally handles AP and finds ways to automate manual invoicing processes while keeping human input central to key decision areas, like payment approvals.

The gold standard in AP automation is "zero touch" automation, where no manual data entry is required, from invoice receipt to vendor payment, except during the approvals process.

Your hotel management group's accounts payable process is complex. Your finance team is responsible for ensuring all invoices from all locations are properly authorized and promptly paid — even a small AP mistake can cause much more than a slight ripple in your system.

Those types of setbacks are not only timeconsuming to find and fix, but costly to your intricate hotel group's ecosystem. Small mistakes can severely disrupt ordering, and worse.

AP automation for your hotel group streamlines and standardizes all accounts payable activities to ensure all locations stick to the same AP structure and make payments on time. Automation eradicates manual AP time-sinks. For example, paperless invoice processing allows your vendor invoices to be submitted electronically, approved electronically, and even paid electronically—without ever physically passing from hand to hand.





Lower Invoice Processing Costs

Manually processing paper invoices is slow and costly. Put plainly, it drains your group's resources, because manual AP procedures require invoice handling, data entry, and reconciliation. That may mean an entire FTE — or several — depending on the number of locations your hotel group oversees from its back office.

Paperless invoice processing, on the other hand, costs less than manual invoice processing. It requires less training, less oversight and far fewer hours to complete. Automation reduces the average cost to process a single invoice from \$9.66 to \$6.21. That's a whopping \$3.45 or 36% less, per invoice.







Faster Invoice Approval Processes

Accrued expenses on the financial statement require backup with the corresponding invoice attached for support. An aging report will tell your auditor how much money is owed to vendors and which AP accounts are over 30-60-90-120 days.



Automatically Split Invoice Items Across Locations

Hotel groups often have invoices that require splitting between locations and departments. AP automation allows for this to be done accurately every time, which saves the CFO time on manual oversight.

Improved Accuracy

Humans make mistakes. The more manual a task, the more room for errors. The most common mistakes — duplicate payments, wrong purchase order or invoice number, incorrectly entered data, payment for items never received — are virtually eliminated with AP automation.





Enhanced Insights and Reporting

AP automation entails digitization of all documents, enabling your hotel group's CFO to quickly and easily access invoices, statements, receipts, and evidence of payment. This allows increased oversight of your hotel's operation and its financial health, and reduces the amount of time spent searching through filing cabinets for historical documentation. Reporting and analytics can help with your budget forecasting, especially now that you have a digitized outline of spend.

Digitally processing and paying invoices makes it easier to close and generate financial reports. Reporting is streamlined, and essentially lightens the hotel's accounting workload.

Increased Transparency




Integration with Existing Systems


Prep Your Team

Plan your implementation with your team. Review your current workflows to determine where you need to streamline. Assign responsibilities and delegate tasks involved with the transition. Encourage open communication throughout the process.

Map Out Your Timeline

Setting a timeline for the transition helps ready your team for the process and be clear on your completion goals. Remember, your hotel group still has daily financial transactions that you must stay on top of while you're in the transition phase.





Ditch Paper For Digital

Ditching paper in favor of digital will be lifechanging for your AP team and your hotel group's future viability. Digitizing all documents is a task that needs to be delegated to ensure all historical invoices and statements are accounted for and uploaded to your AP automation system.

Organize Your Vendor List

Identify and organize your vendor list to figure out monthly spend per vendor. Annotate which vendors accept credit card payments. This will help you calculate all of your potential savings, ranging from available vendor rebates, to cash back, etc.

Notify Your Vendors

Integrations

It's important to choose an AP automation solution that integrates with your current systems. There's no need to tear apart every system you already have in place that's working well for your hotel. Paperless invoicing and automatic invoice approval will revolutionize your invoice process from tip to tail, reducing time spent on invoicing by as much as 80%. Automation

A word to the wise: world-class invoice automation uses neural network-based artificial intelligence (AI) and Optical Character Recognition (OCR) for invoice digitization, because those technologies are best able to process handwriting, non-standard invoice formats, and other less-than-pristine documentation that your standard, rules-based OCR would struggle to handle.

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Bill Pay

You must have the ability to pay vendors electronically (and remotely) within your AP automation platform for a true zero-touch process. It's important that you're able to pay on your own terms (like a partial invoice payment, due to missing or damaged goods) and through a variety of payment methods.


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
